Key Stage 2 SATs

Key Stage 1 SATs

Next week, Year 2 will undergo assessments in the form of Key Stage 1 (KS1) SATs tests. These tests are optional national curriculum tests administered at the end of Year 2 to assess children's progress in English and Maths. They are not mandatory and schools decide whether to use them. The tests help teachers make assessments of a child's progress and identify areas where they may need additional support as they move into Key Stage 2.
